

Welcome to University Transfer

Enrolment is the final step after you've been accepted, paid your tuition deposit, and the timetable has been set.

- You will **choose your courses** with your Academic Advisor.
- You can expect an **email** from the Academic Advisor beginning **2-3 months before the program start date**. It will include instructions on how to book an appointment to choose your courses.
- Appointment times are released based on the calendar availability of the Academic Advisor. You will be contacted in the order of the date your tuition deposit was paid. Your patience is appreciated while you await the email.
- Once you've been enrolled, your schedule will be available in My Lakeland.

~Please ensure you check your email (including your junk mail folder) regularly~

Most University programs require additional grade 12 courses. It is your responsibility to ensure you are enrolled in or have completed all pre-requisites for your chosen degree. If you are missing a pre-requisite, the Academic Advisor will help you develop a plan to complete it during your first year at Lakeland. Missing a pre-requisite will increase the time it will take to complete your degree.

University Collaborations

Did you know we have several collaborations with universities in Alberta and Saskatchewan?

1. Athabasca University allows you to complete arts and science degrees here on campus. You would be required to take at least 10 classes online. We offer:
 - 3-year Human Resources and Labor Relations
 - 3-year Bachelor of Arts with concentrations in general, history, psychology, and sociology.
 - 4-year Bachelor of Arts with majors in history, political economy, psychology, and sociology.
 - 4-year Bachelor of Science with majors in applied math, general, and biological sciences.
2. The University of Alberta allows you to complete years 3 and 4 of a Bachelor of Elementary Education online through their Aboriginal Teacher Education Program (ATEP).
3. The University of Calgary allows you to complete a Bachelor of Education through their Community-Based Education program. This is a blended delivery.
4. The University of Saskatchewan allows you to complete years 2-4 of a Bachelor of Science in Nursing on the Lloydminster campus.

Students who plan to complete a collaboration through Lakeland, must still apply and meet the universities requirements
